**BEARING IMPORTATION CHECKLIST**

Bearings are specially important and most difficult today because of the numerous anti dumping cases presently open. Section 141.80(a) CF requires additional information for certain classes of merchandise. One class of merchandise being ball or roller bearings classifiable under subheading 8482.10.50 through 8482.80.00 HTS. To allow the U.S. Customs Service to complete the required processing of "bearing" import entries the below listed items should be completed.

**1. Type of Bearing: (circle one only)**
